

Sunday, June 2, 2024 – Corpus Christi: Today's feast of the Body and Blood of Christ invites us to consider another aspect of our response to Him. We are so used to focusing on "doing," but at its heart, the mystery of the Eucharist is focused on "being" more than "doing". Just as the bread and wine become the Body and Blood of the Lord at Mass, so do we become the Body of Christ when we gather for worship and receive Him in Holy Communion and Holy Eucharist. So when we bow and say "Amen" just before receiving the Eucharist, we can say in our hearts, "We will be everything the Lord has made us to be." *"Jesus, thank You for giving me a share in Your Body and Blood, Your Soul and Divinity!"*

Celebration of the Immaculate Heart of Mary

Bishop McKnight has once again for this year transferred the Celebration of The Immaculate Heart of Mary (normally celebrated on Saturday June 8) to Sunday June 9. Because the Blessed Mother is the principal patroness for our diocese under this title, we celebrate the Immaculate Heart of Mary as a Feast. This applies to all weekend Masses (Saturday evening June 8 and Sunday June 9, 2024). Celebration readings and responsorial palms have been provided by the Diocese and will not be found in the missalettes.

Ordinary Time – What is it?

Christmas Time and Easter Time highlight the central mysteries of the Paschal Mystery, namely, The Incarnation, Death on The Cross, The Resurrection, and Ascension of Jesus Christ, and The Descent of the Holy Spirit at Pentecost. The Sundays and weeks of Ordinary Time, on the other hand, take us through The Life of Christ. This is the time of conversion. This is living the life of Christ. Ordinary Time is a time for growth and maturation, a time in which the mystery of Christ is called to penetrate ever more deeply into history until all things are finally caught up in Christ. The goal, toward which all of history is directed, is represented by the final Sunday in Ordinary Time, the Solemnity of Our Lord Jesus Christ, King of the Universe.
