Sunday, May 26, 2024 – The Holy Trinity: What a beautiful reading for today's feast of the Holty Trinity! Moses' words to the Israelites tell us there is only one God: "the Lord", and He is a wonderful God. He is generous and kind, not like the false gods the pagans worshipped. He is so kind, in fact, that He rescued His people from slavery and led them into the Promised Land. No pagan could say anything like that about their "god". At the heart of understanding who our One True God is, is the proclamation that Our God is a Trinity of Persons; Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. As Father, he treats us with great love and calls us into His family. As Son, He takes on our own humanity and offers it in sacrifice on The Cross. As Holy Spirit, He pours His very life and love into us and empowers us to live the life that mirrors the love of our Heavenly Father.

The Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ (Corpus Christi), June 2, 2024

The words "Corpus Christi" mean "Body of Christ" and are another name for the "Solemnity of the Body and Blood of Christ". The Solemnity is celebrated on the Sunday after Trinity Sunday and, marks with particular emphasis, the doctrine of Christ's real presence—body, blood, soul, and divinity—in the Eucharist. In celebrating the Solemnity, the Corpus Christi Procession will be held at St. Lawrence immediately following the 10:00 AM Mass.

Why should we participate in the Corpus Christi procession? The annual procession on the Feast of Corpus Christi has a special importance and meaning for the pastoral life of the parish and community. When the Eucharist is carried through the street/parish in a solemn procession with singing, parishioners and people of faith give public witness of their faith and devotion toward the Sacrament. The words "Corpus Christi" mean "Body of Christ" and are another name for the "Solemnity of the Body and Blood of Christ" is celebrated on the Sunday after Trinity Sunday. This solemnity marks with particular emphasis the doctrine of Christ's real presence—body, blood, soul, and divinity—in the Eucharist.

What is a Corpus Christi procession?

The Corpus Christi procession, most often held on the Solemnity of the Body and Blood of Christ, is a "public witness of faith and worship of the Most Blessed Sacrament"; the Holy Communion and Worship of the Eucharist Outside Mass. The procession usually begins after the celebration of Mass, at which the host for the procession is consecrated. Placed in a monstrance (a sacred vessel that displays the sacred host to the faithful), the Blessed Sacrament is then carried out of the church and through the streets of the city or neighborhood accompanied by the songs and prayers of the people. Often there are altars decorated along the route where the monstrance is placed and the people are blessed.

Why should we participate in the Corpus Christi procession?

The annual procession on the feast of Corpus Christi has a special importance and meaning for the pastoral life of the parish or city. When the Eucharist is carried through the street in a solemn procession with singing, parishioners and people of faith give public witness of their faith and devotion toward the Sacrament.

Weather permitting, the Corpus Christi Procession will be held at St. Lawrence on June 2, 2024, following the 10 AM Mass.
