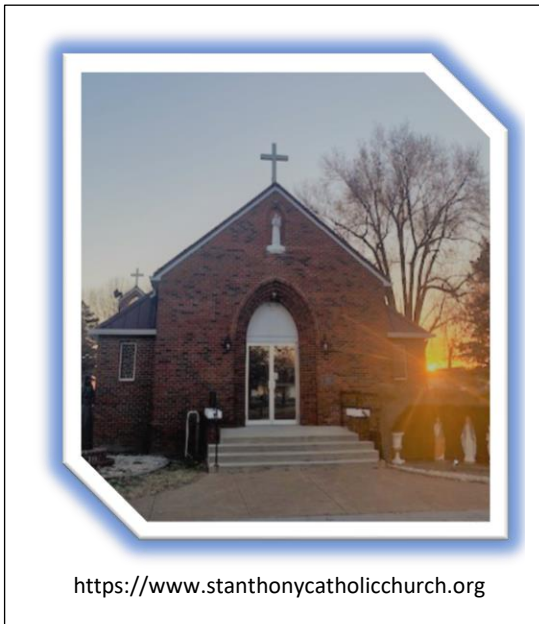

Sunday, August 18, 2024 – Twentieth Sunday in Ordinary Time: In today's Gospel, some of the most powerful words ever spoken by Jesus, were said... *"Amen, amen, I say to you, unless you eat the flesh of the Son of Man and drink his blood, you do not have life within you. Whoever eats my flesh and drinks my blood has eternal life, and I will raise him on the last day. For my flesh is true food, and my blood is true drink. Whoever eats my flesh and drinks my blood remains in me and I in him. Just as the living Father sent me and I have life because of the Father, so also the one who feeds on me will have life because of me. This is the bread that came down from heaven. Unlike your ancestors who ate and still died, whoever eats this bread will live forever".* Jesus means eating is believing, drinking is believing, because Jesus promises eternal life to those who believe in Him.

"Heavenly Father, thank You that JESUS is the Bread of Life and that by partaking in His flesh and drinking of His blood we are cleansed from our sin and have received life everlasting. To You be all praise and glory - in Jesus name I pray."

PARISH & FINANCE COUNCIL MINUTE HIGHLIGHTS

ST. ANTHONY

The St. Anthony Finance Council met on July 31, 2024 to review the 23-24 Budget outcomes and plan/approve the 24-25 Budget. Here's how we did in 23-24:

Total Income:	\$ 162,081.44
Total Expense:	\$ 148,189.50
Net Profit:	\$ 13,891.94

- Of the total income:
 - Offertory Collections \$ 108,556.79
 - Supper Income \$ 42,680.22
 - Other Income \$ 10,844.43
- Of the total expense, Supper Expense was \$ 27,804.09
- \$ 49,405.98 was spent in repairs and improvements (air conditioner units for the Hall, well house, roofing/window wrapping treatments, tuck-pointing on the Church)
- Diocesan Collections: Seminary (\$ 2,206), Mission Sunday (\$ 1,031), Infirm Priest (\$ 1,387)
- 24-25 Budget allows for, but not limited to, light replacement in the Hall and repairs to fryers in the cook shack
- A net profit of about \$16,000 is expected for 24-25.

The St. Anthony Parish Council met on August 8, 2024 and discussed the following: Cook Shack Fryers, Parish Hall Ceiling & Lighting and Air Units, Parish Grounds during Elections, and Fall Supper – October 20, 2024. Prior meetings included topics on Totus TUUS and Confirmation 2025. Next meeting is set for September 12, 6:40 PM.

ST. LAWRENCE

The St. Lawrence Finance Council met on July 23, 2024 to review the 23-24 Budget outcomes and plan/approve the 24-25 Budget. Here's how we did in 23-24:

Total Income:	\$ 451,987.01
Total Expense:	\$ 436,350.22
Net Profit:	\$ 15,636.79

- Of the total income:
 - Offertory Collections \$ 242,209.52
 - Other Income \$ 113,575.37
 - Pipe Organ Donations \$ 96,202.12
- \$ 111,315.70 was spent in repairs and improvements (Cecilia/pipe organ, balcony ventilation, electrical behind rectory)
- Diocesan Collections: Seminary (\$ 13,803), Mission Sunday (\$ 12,321), Infirm Priest (\$ 7,852.75)
- 24-25 Budget allows for, but not limited to, concrete work around and behind the rectory and parish grounds
- A net profit of about \$ 58,000 is expected for 24-25.

The St. Lawrence Parish Council met last on June 19, 2024 and discussed the following: Restorations/Repairs (concrete work, sidewalk heaters, and rectory electrical), upcoming MODOT sidewalk project (Nov/Dec 2024), Hail Damage & Repair to Pavilion, Totus TUUS, and Confirmation 2025. Next meeting is set for August 21, 6:00 PM.
