Sunday, August 25, 2024 – Twenty-First Sunday in Ordinary Time: To whom shall we go? This was a decisive moment for Jesus' disciples. They had seen Him perform miracles, bring people to conversion, and contend with suspicious Jewish leaders. It seemed as if He could do nothing wrong! But now they had to make a hard decision; would they keep following Jesus when He said something they didn't understand? How about when they didn't like what they heard? Perhaps, it was all too much, and most of them "no longer accompanied him" (John 6:66). But Peter, speaking for himself and the rest of the Twelve, cut through the confusion with one simple question: "Master, to whom shall we go?" (John 6:68). There was no one like Jesus. He truly is "the Holy One of God". Peter couldn't let his lack of understanding derail him. He trusted that if he stayed close to Jesus, asked questions, listened carefully, and kept an open heart, he would one day get the answers he sought. Even if it took years, he would still stick with the One whose love and grace had dramatically changed his heart. Do some of Jesus' words confuse you or shock you? Don't let them cast a shadow over everything else you have heard. Certainly don't let them cause you to doubt His love for you and for others. INSTEAD... draw closer to Him. Recall how patient He has been with you, and resolve to be just as patient in waiting for the answers you seek. And remember, you have the gift of faith for just this very purpose. Allow supernatural grace to help you trust in the Lord even when you don't understand. Jesus truly is the Holy One of God. There's nowhere else you can go to receive all he has for you.

"Lord, help me to stay close to You, especially when I have questions."

DEANERY NEWS

What exactly is a Deanery and what's the purpose? Technically, and in part, "canon 374 §2 of the Code of Canon Law provides that several neighboring parishes can be joined together in special groups known as "Vicariates Forane," or Deaneries, for the purpose of fostering pastoral care under a priest appointed by the Diocesan Bishop as the Dean (cf. canons 553-555)". The intent of Deaneries within the Diocese of Jefferson City is to help parishes interact more effectively with each other and receive better administrative support from Bishop McKnight and his staff. The Parishes of St. Anthony of Pauda and St. Lawrence are located in the Southwest Deanery.

Fiscal Year End Financials

The task of the Parish Finance Council is to assist the pastor, who is accountable to the Diocesan Bishop for the administration and stewardship of the temporal goods of his parish. The pastor has the ultimate responsibility for parish financial and temporal management. The parish finance council is a consultative body assisting the pastor in meeting these obligations. By sharing their expertise and experience with the pastor, lay members of the Christian faithful participate in the governance of their parish. The parish finance council assists the pastor in making financial decisions and the sharing of information, consultation, listening, and promoting consensus is at the heart of this process. Finance Councils meet regularly to review and/or approve monthly income/expenditures and annual budgets. Questions pertaining to your parish's financials can be directed to your Parish Council President. The following, long-standing, bank accounts make up each parish's respective budget.

Main - General operating income and expenses.

<u>Stipend</u> - Mass Intentions and votive candle income and expense. Mass stipends for Mass intentions are held here until Masses are fulfilled (said). After Mass is fulfilled, the stipend is then transferred to Main Account.

<u>Parish Project/Restoration</u> - Income and expenses related specifically to restoration and improvements of parish buildings and grounds.

<u>Diocesan</u> - Pastor and Finance Council approved monies under the investment direction by the Diocese of Jefferson City. Fund availability, to the parish, is dependent on fund type: short-term or long-term.
