



November 3, 2024 Daily Reflection – 31st Sunday in Ordinary Time. Higher-end cameras have a setting called "portrait mode," which focuses only on the face of the individual you are trying to capture while blurring out everything in the background. In today's Gospel, Jesus congratulates a scribe who has come to see God in this way. The scribe understands loving God and His people is the most important thing he can do. Everything else is background; not erased, of course, but secondary when compared to the main picture. We all lose focus now and then and especially on and for Our Lord. Maybe your gaze was fixed on a new pricey luxury, job, to-do's, deadlines, or someone or something from the past. We just get bogged down with emotions and become unaware until the challenges get to be too much and *THEN* we wake up to our predicament or problem. **So how can we keep focus on the Lord as this scribe did?** We can start by remembering to dedicate even the ordinary parts of our days to the Lord. We can make a morning promise or offering to Him the minute we wake up and lift up prayers throughout the day. We can invite the Lord and the Holy Spirit into our meetings, discussions, and not-sopleasant, difficult conversations. OR sometimes, all it takes is a glance toward Heaven to refocus our hearts on Him. Loving God with all our hearts doesn't have to be an intense, all-day prayer marathon. The more you do this, the more you'll find your preoccupations and worries fading into the background.
